COBURG URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY BUDGET COMMITTEE MESSAGE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22

Dear Citizens and Budget Committee Members

This budget continues the agency's practice of contributing funds to the City of Coburg Sewer Debt Fund for debt service loan payments. This fulfills the mission of the agency to "Assist the City of Coburg with the financing of the wastewater system".

The Funding of Sewer Debt was designed with the development of the Urban Renewal District. The limitation of contribution to the sewer fund was set at approximately \$9,000,000. Given the current transfers it is assumed that this will be reached somewhere around 2032, unless an adjustment to the URD is made.

It is anticipated that the Urban Renewal Agency will have revenues of \$412,000 consisting of Tax Receipts and Interest Income in fiscal year 2022. This is a \$5,000 decrease in anticipated receipts for 2021. Expenses are limited to administrative costs of the district in the amount of \$8,775 which will be consistent with anticipated expenses in 2021 with the exception of an increase in the cost of the audit for 2021. The budget also reflects \$400,000 transferred to the City Sewer Debt Department which is consistent with Fiscal Year 2021.

In keeping with process established, the transfer to the City for 2021 and years after should be the majority of tax receipts leaving minimal cash balance. In 2021 the ending balance will be approximately \$50,000 in the URA to be carried over in order to cover the administration of the

agency such as the audit, administrative services expense, public notices, bank fees, etc. The fund balance represents cash on hand as the Urban Renewal District has no Capital Assets.

As the Sewer project was completed and the Sewer Fund as well as the Urban Renewal Agency moved to an "operations mode", a policy driven discussion took place regarding the purpose and use of the Urban Renewal tax receipts. This budget reflects those discussions.

TAX ANTICIPATION

An analysis of tax receipts for the URD (Urban Renewal District) is included in this packet. It reflects a \$5,000 decreased in budgeted tax receipts for 2022. Tax receipts in 2021 will fall short of budgeted \$410,000 by 2%. The County predicts only slight growth in 2022 and therefore we have budgeted for projected \$405,000 in tax revenues.
