

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-04

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING OREGON STATE TRANSPORTATION MONIES FROM THE STATE OF OREGON SPECIAL ALLOTMENT GRANT FOR FY 2012.

WHEREAS, Funds have been set up in a separate account to be administrated by the Oregon Transportation Commission and to be allotted each year by said commission to be spent, within cities of 5,000 or fewer persons, upon streets not a part of the state highway system that are inadequate for the capacity they serve, or are in a condition detrimental to safety;

WHEREAS, the City of Coburg is an incorporated City of the State of Oregon and has a population of less than 5,000 as given by the latest official federal census;

WHEREAS, the City Council did authorize City Staff to participate in said program with Resolution No. 2011-12; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coburg has been awarded an Oregon Transportation Commission Special Allotment Grant for FY 2012 in the amount of \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Coburg, does hereby find, declare, and resolve:

1. The Coburg City Council formally accepts the Oregon Transportation Commission Special Allotment Grant for FY 2012.
2. The Coburg Finance Director is authorized to take all steps necessary to receive the Special Allotment Grant and to deposit the funds appropriately.
