

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-10**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES**

**WHEREAS, ORS 221.760, provides as follows:**

**Section 1.** The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection
- (3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewer
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (7) One or more utility services, and,

**WHEREAS,** city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760,

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**Be it resolved,** that the City of Coburg hereby certifies that it provides the following four municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760: Police protection; Street construction, maintenance, and lighting; Planning, zoning, and subdivision control; and Water Utility Service.
