

## RESOLUTION NO. 2013-15

### A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REVISED WATER RATES

WHEREAS, it is the general policy of the Coburg City Council that enterprise funds supporting the operation of such infrastructure systems like the water system should operate on a self-sustaining basis; and

WHEREAS, in the recent past the Water System rates have not reflected that policy in that they have depleted Water System reserves for operating expenses, thus reducing the City's ability to provide for future maintenance and improvements to the Coburg Water system; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the City that corrections be made immediately to the Water Rates to put them on a self-sustaining basis.

WHEREAS City Council discussed the water rate study results and possible scenarios at the April, May, June City Council meetings and where a Public Hearing was held June 25, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COBURG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Rates as set forth in the Water Rate Table set forth herein shall become effective as of July 1, 2013.
