RESOLUTION NO. 2005-06 (2)

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR THE IMPOUNDMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The City Council of the City of Coburg finds as follows:

- A. Under the laws of the State of Oregon, the City of Coburg Police Department is legally obligated to impound motor vehicles or provide custodial care of other personal property. In such situations, the City of Coburg incurs increased expenses for insurance, storage and personnel.
- B. Section 809.270 of the Oregon Motor Vehicle Code contains provisions for a police agency to assess an administrative fee sufficient to recover the actual administrative costs for the impoundment of motor vehicles or custodial care of other personal property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Coburg hereby certifies that:

- **Section 1.** The City establishes an administrative fee for the impoundment of motor vehicles or custodial care of other property in the amount of \$110.00 to recover the City's increased expenses for insurance, storage and personnel.
- **Section 2.** The administrative fee provided herein shall be in addition to all other costs, expenses or charges that the City has lawful authority to collect or impose in such circumstances.
- **Section 3.** Property, lawfully impounded by, or in the custodial care of, the City shall not be released to the owner(s) or person(s) lawfully entitled thereto until payment of all fees, charges, costs and expenses have been made.
- **Section 4.** This Resolution shall apply from its effective date to all vehicles or other personal property, then impounded by, or within the custodial care of the City.
- **Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon Council adoption and approval by the Mayor.
